



Estonian aquabike rules 2017a.

Rules are governed by U.I.M. aquabike rules, except next points:

1. Race duration:

Estonian Championship

- RunaboutGP1 15 minutes + 1 lap
- Runabout GP2 15 minutes + 1 lap
- Runabout GP4 12 minutes + 1 lap
- Runabout Beginner GP2 10 minutes + 1 lap
- SKI GP1 15 minutes + 1 lap
- SKI GP2 12 minutes + 1 lap
- SKI GP3 12 minutes + 1 lap
- Junior SKI GP3 10 minutes + 1 lap
- Ladies SKI GP1 12 minutes + 1 lap

Estonian Cup

- Runabout GP3 15 minutes + 1 lap*
- Runabout Beginner GP2 10 minutes + 1 lap
- SKI Beginner GP1 10 minutes + 1 lap
- SKI Veteran GP1 12 minutes + 1 lap

* Runabout GP3 class must have minimum 5 riders to have a race.

Estonian Championship Enduro

- Endurance SKI GP 30 minutes
- Runabout GP 90 minutes

2. Estonian Championship and Estonian Cup has three rounds and every round has two motos. All rounds and motos will scored by U.I.M. scoring system.
3. Class will be counted as Estonian Championship round if there is minimum three Estonian riders or five together with foreign riders. This rule does not apply on last championship round.
4. For separate start there must be minimum five riders in class.
5. Free practise and time trial is together. Practise starts with two laps behind the course marshall to get to know the race track. Speeding and change of places is prohibited at this time. After two laps with course marshall continues 15 minutes timed training. Riders with best laptimes can choose start positions. Riders who did not get times will be last to choose starting position by decision of O.O.D. and in order of race numbers.

6. False start – Rider who has done false start will be started with dead engine, one hand on helmet and stays without holder, for runabout stays one holder.

7. Protest – protest fee is 80 € ja technical protest fee is 200 €. Protest fee is payable in cash at the time of lodging the protest. All protests must be in writing - type written or hand written.

8. Jury – The jury will be composed of 3 - 5 members. Jury chairman is organiser or member of aquabike commission. Jury members are representatives of foreign countries. In case there is no participation from foreign countries jury members will be selected at drivers briefing.

9. The shorts are not allowed as race wear/equipment.

10. Between two motos there is taking the group picture. Participation is mandatory with wetsuits, the helmet and the racing bib.

11. Point system – will be used U.I.M. scoring system. Runabout GP1, SKI GP1 and Ladies SKI GP1 will be added to UIM-ABP aquabike world rankings.
